
Strengthening Women's Leadership, Dakhsinpuri, Delhi





Stories Of Change



I'm Baburam Bijoli, a tea seller from Tollygunge Golf Club Road in South Kolkata. Since 2017, I've been part of the Golf Club Road Men's Group, aiming for gender equality. I've transformed from holding traditional beliefs about women to respecting their choices and advocating for equal rights. I've acknowledged past mistakes, such as forcing my wife to dress a certain way, and I'm deeply sorry for that. Joining the Men's Group opened my eyes to the importance of treating women as equals. Through meetings and training, I've embraced the idea that men and women should enjoy the same freedoms, and I'm committed to challenging patriarchal norms"

Subir Dey of Chinna Mandir B1 faced a cybercrime situation in June 2023 when a fake Facebook profile was created using his acquaintance's personal information and inappropriate content. Subir took action by contacting the Crisis Centre of CHSJ, which advised him to escalate the complaint to the Kolkata Lalbazar Police Headquarters. Together with other affected classmates, they filed complaints, and the police supported their efforts, taking action against the hackers. Their collective effort led to a positive outcome as authorities took the matter seriously, and the hacker deactivated the fake accounts. This experience demonstrates the power of people uniting to protect their rights and safety.
