Movie Day with Women Leaders

To address societal issues and to raise awareness, we organised movie screening of the movie "Brahma Janen Gopon Kommoti" with our women leaders to highlight Gender Equality and Women Rights, in five different communities: Dakhin Diyara, Jhorobasti, Jodhpur Park 1, Mahabirtala and K.P. Roy Lane. This film emphasised the significance of women standing up for their rights, especially in places where they are often left out.



Second Phase of Digital Literacy Training

We conducted the second phase of Digital Literacy training, focusing on advanced skills on mobile-based technology. Women Leaders of Samadhan Dal were trained on Financial Transactions, the use of Google Maps, Social Media apps, Conference Calls, etc. to make them independent both socially and economically, which eventually will lead to empowerment.



Legal Awareness Camp



A Legal Awareness Camp was organised in Chetla, South Kolkata, to discuss and aware women on laws that protect women's rights, such as the Protection for Women against Domestic Violence Act (PWDVA) and POCSO Act.

Jashn-e- Agaaz



We participated in “Jashn-e-Agaaz, an inspiring youth-led festival organised by Pravah. It was a Youth Centric Development Model where youth socialise and collaborate with different organisations. The event played as a platform to discuss and strategise to deal with the prevalent societal issues. During the event, our representatives talked about how they imagine an equitable society and ways to achieve it, also they talked about how the initiative of Positive Masculinity brought the change in boys and men and society at large.

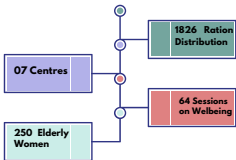

Safety audits were conducted in 4 different communities with the help of 51 auditors. As a result the issues of Street Light, cleanliness, Health and Hygiene, Security as a whole, Police Patrolling and issues of Alcoholism came into notice.

PUA was conducted in two areas with 24 women volunteers. Post PUA it came to light that issues of Domestic Violence and Street Sexual Harassment are on the rise, with Economic Oppression of marginalised women emerging as a new threat.
