LEADERSHIP TRAINING IN DOOARS

PURSUIT OF EMPOWERMENT AND UNITY



Empowering Domestic Workers is our mission, and we understand the significance of a uniform in achieving this goal. By giving 400 Domestic Workers distinctive Aprons, we are not just providing clothing; we are fostering a strong sense of Belonging and Unity. This shared commitment spans various locations, including K.P Roy Lane, Jodhpur Park 1, Chinamandir A and B1, Ballygunge, Mahabirtala, and 10 more, symbolising our collective dedication to Empowerment.

TRAINING FOR TRAINERS

Thirty women Community Leaders from two districts over three days from November 1 to November 4, 2023, were trained in a workshop organised in Digha. The main objective of the session was to identify violence and address the potential threats that can come up in the communities like Domestic Violence, harassment, etc.



DURGA PUJA PREPARATION



In the vibrant September of 2023, our Durga Puja celebration reached new heights with shared joy and meaningful connections. To ignite the festive spirit, we gifted Sarees to 200 Didas. Embarking on a campaign, we unveiled the untold stories of domestic workers, showcasing unique facet of Durga Puja. Through insightful interviews with both employers and employees, we promoted the cultivation of a strong and positive bond between them, adding depth and richness to the festivities.



16 DAYS OF ACTIVISM AGAINST GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE

Kolkata

During the 16 Days of Activism, the team displayed notable dedication through activities such as poster creation, banner design, workshops, quiz, rallies, and more. Their meticulous planning and enthusiasm were evident in the execution of the entire agenda across diverse Locations, including K.P Roy Lane, Jadavpur, Dhakuria, Jodhpur Park, Jhorobasti, Chetla, Mohonhar Pukar, Shahid Smriti, and ten additional sites experienced impactful Awareness Campaigns, featuring quiz, rallies, and poster making, playing football by women and girls effectively reached these areas.



Delhi

In Delhi, we organised 16 Days of Activism against Gender-Based Violence in our community Dakshinpuri, Delhi. We set up a stall on the theme of “Clothes can’t justify Rapes” to raise awareness regarding this sensitive issue.



GENDER MELA

Gender Mela was the concluding event of 16 days of Activism against Gender-Based Violence, organised on December 6, 2023 in which more than 1500 women directly participated along with 300 community members. Through engaging and enjoyable games, awareness about Gender-Based Violence was effectively raised. The impact reached 5000 indirect participations facilitated through Social media, Leaflets, and other outreach methods.



TRAINING ON POSITIVE MASCULINITIES

CHSJ partnered as a knowledge partner with CECOEDECON and UNFPA, Rajasthan, and organised a training workshop on 20 and 21 December 2023 in Sawai Madhopur, Rajasthan. More than fifty youth leaders and peer educators participated. The training helped the peer educators to develop a deep understanding on patriarchy, masculinity, and how it affects gender norms and gender relations so that they can lead the discussion on these in their communities and create a peer group to work on Positive Masculinities.
