SETU healthcare began in January 2024 aiming at - Strengthening Entillement- Awareness Towards Universal health care among marginalised communities in Pratapgarh, Uttar Pradesh. The project drives to understand prevailing health beliefs, practices, awareness levels, and barriers to healthcare Service utilisation, encompassing Ayushman Bharat health insurance program and to evaluate the readiness and competence of frontline health workers and community organisations in providing suitable services to the Marginalised communities of Pratapgarh.

A comprehensive desk review of related literature, along with direct angagement with the community, is currently underway in the Patti Block of Pratapgarh district. This process aims to gather valuable insights into local healthcare dynamics, including prevalent beliefs, practices, and challenges, to ensure project initiatives effectively.
